
30-Day Moving Checklist





Moving Tips



- Wrap your breakables (dishes, glasses, etc.) in clothing to save on bubble wrap.
- In addition to labeling what's in your boxes, add what room they'll be going into, as well. Boxes should be able to close without caving or bulging.
- Take a picture of how your electronics are connected so you can remember where the wires go.
- Place a cotton pad into your powder cosmetics to keep them from breaking.
- · Cover the openings of your toiletries with saran wrap, then put the tops back on to prevent leaking.
- Pack plates vertically.
- Take photos of your cleaned out residence in order to get your proper deposit back. (Tip: Use a bar of soap to fill your nail holes).
- If possible, arrive at your new residence before the movers to pre-clean.
- Items valued at more than \$100/lb should be disclosed to your Move & Store representative; they will assist in making sure that you are properly insured for your move.



APPLIANCES

Disconnect, desfrost and ensure all appliances are empty of items



COMPUTERS/TELEVISIONS

Pack into original boxes if available.



CLOTHING

Hang clothes in wardrobe boxes to keep them organized and on hangers.



LAMPS

Remove shades and bulbs and pack them into boxes with lots of padding.



DISHES

Pack in dish boxes vertically. 3" of paper on botoom and 2" in between layers.



BEDS

Remove all sheets and mattress pads. We will disassemble and resassemble.

Items Movers Cannot Transport

- Bleach
- Aerosols
- House Paints
- Fire Extinguishers

- Liquid antifreeze
- Propane cans/tanks
- Firearms or ammunition
- Money
